Job Brief

Sharks (all chondrichthyan fishes) are facing an unprecedented rate of extinction due to continued overexploitation and habitat loss. The most landed species of shark globally is the blue shark *Prionace glauca*, with estimates of between 10-20 million animals landed yearly across its circumglobal tropical and temperate distribution. In recent years, there has been an increase in popularity for swimwith tourism, including in the UK. We are working with swim-with operators to develop and implement sustainable guidelines – including a Code of Conduct. We are looking for someone to help us with data input, analysis and reporting. You will work closely with the Director to ensure timely delivery of results.

Qualifications

The ideal candidate will have the following:

- BSc or above in biology, marine biology, environmental science or similar degree. Relevant experience will also be considered;
- Strong analytical and computer skills, with confident use of GIS and R;
- Experience with remotely-sensed data analyses and interpretation desirable;

- Ability to work remotely;
- Experience with in-water marine megafauna research a good plus;
- Strong work ethic to work independently and results-oriented;
- Strong organisational skills;
- Ability to travel and help with an in-person event in Bristol (travel covered);
- UK-based and able to produce invoices.
